

Chairman's report

The Association is filing micro accounts for 2018, as in the last couple of years.

2018's income was slightly up on last year. Donations and the rental income from the Old Edwardians Sports Club Limited were much as last year, and EFG Harris Allday have again (with our thanks) maintained the return on our portfolio.

The surplus allows the Association to make a bigger contribution to Assisted Places this year of £12,000, with smaller amounts made available to other Old Edwardian related causes as in previous years.

The Association's contribution last year to the Weaver brothers' third film has been gratefully acknowledged in the credits. If you have not, please do watch it.

As can be seen from the Balance Sheet, we have maintained our capital at £175,000 with which to earn further income and continue to make contributions which will help the School and our alumni.

Many thanks to all of them, past and present, and to the alumni who make it worth doing.
